### **Overview & Responsibilities:**

#### **GENERAL ACCOUNTABILITIES**

Responsible for the care, removal and transport of human remains in accordance with all state, local and company policies and procedures.

#### **SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Performs removals of deceased from hospital, nursing home or residence to transport to Personal Care Center, mortuary or funeral home.
- May perform removals from prep rooms or embalming facilities as well.
- Maintains and ensures removal vehicle is clean inside and out and is properly maintained.
- Maintains adequate supply of Personal Protective Equipment in removal vehicles
- Performs duties with strict adherence to Indification Policies and Procedures

### **Requirements & Qualifications:**

#### **Education:**

- High School or GED equivalent

#### **Experience:**

- Minimum of six (6) months work experience

#### **Certification/License:**

- Valid Driver's License with a Clean Driving Record

#### **Knowledge, Skills & Abilities:**

- Professional appearance required
- Ability to follow instructions given over the phone or in person
- Ability to work and communicate effectively with others
- Ability to work with kindness and compassion for the deceased and their families
- Ability to work in a fast paced environment.

- Must be able to work on a rotating on call schedule
